

BYLAW # 12/2004

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Briercrest in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW of the village.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the village for which no other fine is provided and which, such bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
3. Subject to the provision of section 2, any person found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the village, passed by authority of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$300.00 nor more than \$800.00 and costs for every offence.
4. General Penalty Bylaw No. 5, 1985 passed August 14, 1985 is hereby repealed.
