BYLAW # 12/2004

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Briercrest in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW of the village.
- 2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the village for which no other fine is provided and which, such bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
- 3. Subject to the provision of section 2, any person found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the village, passed by authority of *The Urban Municipality Act*, 1984, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$300.00 nor more than \$800.00 and costs for every offence.
- 4. General Penalty Bylaw No. 5, 1985 passed August 14, 1985 is hereby repealed.
