BYLAW NO. 6-2015

A BYLAW REPECTING FIREWORKS

A Bylaw of the Village of Briercrest to prohibit fireworks.

The Council of the Village of Briercrest in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

- 1. In this Bylaw,
 - (a) "fireworks" means firecrackers, rocket, squib or any object or substance designed to be exploded or burned to produce noises or brilliant lighting effects and does not include paper percussion caps for toy guns.
 - (b) "fireworks display" shall mean a display of fireworks for the entertainment of the public at large.

2. Prohibition

 No person shall set off, detonate, ignite or cause to be exploded any fireworks in the Village of Briercrest at any time whatsoever, provided that this section shall not apply to a fireworks display.

3. Displays

- 1. The council of the Village of Briercrest may, at their discretion, issue a permit in writing, in Form "A", authorizing a firework display under the supervision of a licensed pyrotechnician.
- 2. A fireworks display shall be held only in the ball diamonds area also known as Parcel A, Plan BS1284 or other places approved by Council.
- A permit issued under clause (1) of this section shall prescribe the conditions which a
 display of fireworks may be held in the Village of Briercrest and no person shall conduct a
 display of fireworks in contravention of such prescribed conditions.

4. Penalties

 Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties as provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Briercrest.

This Bylaw shall come into force on the 12th day of November, 2015.
